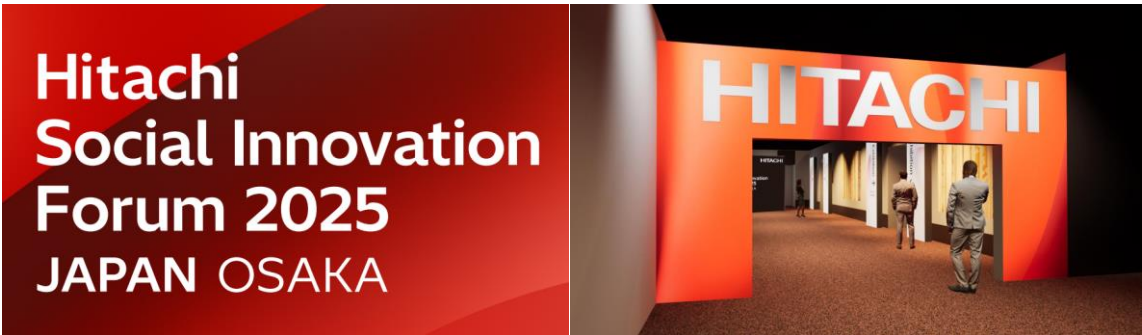


Hitachi Group to hold its largest scale event “Hitachi Social Innovation Forum 2025 JAPAN” in Osaka for the first time
